Global United For A Better Life Foundation motto is to get people independent. This profound philosophy is what we will apply to our GCC (Global Community Centers)

GCC's are our long term projects. Commencing in places like Haiti and Costa Rica. GCC's are community centers that will become the doorway for many communities to interact around the world. These GCC's will be built mainly in poverty stricken areas. Our leadership team will be prepared to bring transformation and to assess what kind of education, skills and knowledge will be needed for that area.

The assessment will show us what kind of knowledge the community is lacking and will help us bring the resources, professionals and infrastructure to make the GCC work and create independent individuals, that thrive and use the new acquired skills and education to elevate their own community.

GCC's will count on:

1. Workshop building to impart trading skills according to the area. For example, if agriculture was to be the main source of income for a community, workshops will be available to certify people in the farming of their resources.



2. Sport complex, oriented to promote sport programs like soccer, baseball, football. We will form leagues providing sportswear, equipment and coaches.
3. Kitchen and Dining hall. Having nutritious food is a very important part of daily activities. *If we are what we eat, then healthy is the way to go.* From teaching culinary arts to having the food to feed those attending campuses. The Kitchen can also provide meals to go among others programs that we will be adapting according to the community needs.
4. Centers will also count with a library with the necessary technology to create connections from campus to campus internationally. This will incentivise multicultural knowledge by allowing the exchange of information, learning new cultures and new languages.
5. Impartation classes and workshops: some will be local, some others will be podcast, imparted via Zoom or other online systems, depending on the availability to have a teacher, bringing the knowledge online in many cases will be preferred. Each GCC will have the ability to keep contact with other centers and schedule conferences available live, online to share progress and innovative ideas.
